

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-08

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$667,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$667,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Acquisition and installation of fixtures and equipment for the Fire Department including a fixed location Cascade System for filling air bottles and an electronic message board.	\$ 101,000
(b) Acquisition of replacement Computer Assisted Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System for use in the Police Department, including software, equipment, installation and training.	\$ 51,000
(c) Construction of Sidewalks along Jacksonville Road replace deteriorated and heaved sections of Sidewalk; Construction of ADA Compliant Intersection Ramps, Replacement of unsafe sidewalk sections and Curb Improvements throughout the Township.	\$ 86,000
(d) Purchase and installation of park and safety equipment including replacement benches, bleachers, fencing and backstops; Improvements to Washington Park including irrigation, parking improvements, sidewalks and park equipment; Development and construction of a Skate Park; improvements to include design, engineering and related acquisition costs.	\$ 429,000
TOTAL	\$ 667,000


SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$35,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.


SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
