ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$170,000 FROM THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE WATER UTILITY IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

**SECTION 1**. \$170,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

(a) Purchase of a replacement 5 CY Dump Truck for use	\$ 170,000
by the Water Division within the Department of Public.	
TOTAL	\$ 170,000

**SECTION 2**. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$2,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

**SECTION 3**. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

**SECTION 4**. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
