Jean Gail and Sue participated in a CDC webinar about emerging cases of Chikungunya, which is a virus transmitted by mosquitoes. The most common symptoms are fever and joint pain. Other symptoms may include headache, muscle pain, joint swelling, or rash.

In late 2013, Chikungunya virus was found for the first time in the Americas on islands in the Caribbean.

There is a risk that the virus will be imported to new areas by infected travelers. There is no vaccine to prevent Chikungunya, treatment is symptomatic

Florham Park: 2 cases of Vaccine Preventable Diseases, both pertussis (1 turned out not a case, 1 was probable)

Pequannock: 2 cases of 'other'

- 1 case of strep pneumonia
- 1 case of babesiosis
