Brookdale (Legionella) update:

- A third chlorination (100 ppm for 3 hour holding time) of the water system was done along with resampling
- A second plumbing assessment is scheduled for April
- Evaluation of the public water supply will be conducted by LHD; HO to meet with borough administrator and water utility to review local sampling; Garden State Labs will be consulted with regards to sampling
- Surveillance continues for additional legionella cases @ Brookdale; immunocompromised clients continue to be bathed and drink bottled water
