# PV Park Badge Information 2016

\*All badges will be for the 2016 calendar year!

**Badge Renewal:** If you already have a badge from 2013, you may renew your badge through the online system, Community Pass. To access this, you may find the link on the township homepage, [peqtwp.org](http://peqtwp.org) on the bottom right. The website can also be accessed by typing in **register.communitypass.net/pequannock**. Once you have paid, the barcode on your badge will automatically update for the new season.

**1<sup>st</sup> Time Badge Members:** If you would like to become a member of PV Park, you will need to do the following: Register online through the Community Pass system. This link can be found on the township homepage, [peqtwp.org](http://peqtwp.org) on the bottom right. The website can also be accessed by typing in **register.communitypass.net/pequannock**. Once there, you must create an account and follow the prompts. After creating the account and paying for the badges online, come to the Parks and Recreation office to get a picture and badge. Anyone over the age of 2 must have a badge.

**Lost Badges:** If you happen to misplace your badge, come to the Parks and Recreation Office and purchase a new badge. The lost badge fee is \$20.

**Gate Guards:** Each time you enter the facility you will be asked to present the gate guard with your badge for scanning.

# PV Park and Woodland Lake FAQs

**Q:** How do we treat the water at the lakes?

**A:** The Township contracts with Black Lagoon Pond Management to treat the water for algae. Our water is full of high nutrient concentrations from fertilizers, rich soils and waterfowl wastes that flows into the lake. These conditions are favorable for the growth of algal and weeds. For this reason, chemical treatment can maintain an acceptable level of water quality.

Most of the problems with water quality at PV Park are associated with algae growth. Black Lagoon Pond Control applies an EPA-registered Cutrine-Plus for algae control, designed for application on a regular basis, in low dose amounts, to maximize algae control and minimize the potential for adverse environmental risk. The lake is treated every 10-14 days .

PV Park has three above water aerators and an under water aeration system that circulates the water. Also, the spillway between PV Park and Woodland Lake has been reopened allowing cool water from Woodland Lake to spill into PV Park therefore providing better circulation.

**Q:** Why does the lake close?

**A:** The Pequannock Township Health Department takes water samples around the lake once a week for bacteria levels which are sent to Garden State Laboratory to measure fecal coliform. If the samples return high again, the decision is made to either cordon off the specific area or close the facility.

**Q:** Can non-residents bring guest?

**A:** YES! Non- residents may bring up to 5 guest(s).

**Q:** Can non- residents come to the lake for the day?

**A:** All non-residents attending the lake for the day must be with someone that has a season badge or a township resident to be admitted.

6. No limit on the number of pan fish. Limit on trout: brown, brook, and rainbow is 3 per day. Limit on large mouth bass is 1 per day and must be over 18". \*Large Mouth Bass closed (Catch & Release) during NJ State Spawning dates.
7. Unlawful to use net of any kind and no spears or projectiles of any make will be allowed.
8. No fish are to be cleaned in the Park and all fish taken from the Lake must be removed from the Park.
9. Polluting and littering violate Township ordinances. Please help keep the Lake clean and litter free by using the trash receptacles provided.
10. No bat fish are to be taken from the Lake at any time. **Bait:** No killy or brackish water bait is to be used.
11. **Hours:** 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, unless otherwise noted.
12. ICE FISHING IS PROHIBITED unless designated by the Director of Parks and Recreation, or the Park Ranger.
13. Rowboats, kayaks, canoes, sailboats, and inflatable boats will be the only type of craft permitted. Electronic motors powered by a 12 volt battery are permitted.
14. Inflatable boats must contain two or more chambers and must be inspected by the Park Rangers before being registered for use on the lake.
15. Boat size must be between 8' and 14'. Canoe size must be between 10' and 16' and sailboat size must be between 8' and 14'.
16. Night fishing will be allowed as long as a LIGHT IS DISPLAYED.
17. Only those facilities, which are provided by the Lake for launching, are to be used.
18. The proper number of Coast Guard approved flotation devices must be in each craft at all times, one for each passenger in the boat. Each passenger must wear a life jacket. The number of passengers must not exceed the designed capacity of the boat.
19. Swimming or wading is prohibited.
20. Members may bring up to FIVE guests. No guest fee or badge is needed.

**\*ALL PERSONS OPERATING A POWERED VESSEL MUST POSSESS A VALID NEW JERSEY BOAT OPERATORS LICENSE. POWER BOAT OWNERS MUST ALSO REGISTER THEIR BOAT WITH THE STATE.**

## 2016 Rules and Regulations

### PV Park

*PV Park Rules & Regulations are designed to help insure the safety and enjoyment of all park members. Failure to comply with the policies set may result in suspension or forfeiture of lake privileges. The following policies are based on Township Ordinances; prosecution may result from abuses to these rules.*

1. The 25 meter lanes are available for lap swimming. The buddy system must be used and permission obtained from a lifeguard or the lake managers.
2. Inflatable water paraphernalia is restricted to the shallow area. (This includes toys, beach balls, inner tubes, snorkels, facemasks, fins, etc.)
3. Strictly prohibited:
  - Disorderly conduct
  - Horseplay, ball playing (except in designated areas)
  - Littering
  - Alcoholic beverages
4. Music and television volumes must be kept at a level low enough not to disturb other park users.
5. Diaper changing is limited to the restroom facilities only. Changing tables are located in both men's and ladies room. Swim diapers must be worn!

# 2016 Rules and Regulations

## Woodland Lake

*Woodland Lake Rules & Regulations are designed to help insure the safety and enjoyment of all park members. Failure to comply with the policies set may result in suspension or forfeiture of lake privileges. The following are based on Township Ordinances, prosecution may result from abuses to these rules.*

### Fishing and Boating Regulations

1. All boats must be registered with the Parks & Recreation Department. There is a \$10 fee per boat. Annual registrations are valid January 1- December 31.
2. All boat decals must be displayed on the right front of the boat.
3. No person under the age of fourteen (14) shall be permitted to boat at Woodland Lake without supervision of an adult eighteen (18) years of age or older.
4. All persons fishing over 14 years of age must display a NJ State fishing license. (A trout stamp is also necessary when taking trout.)
5. PV Park or Woodland Lake badge must be with you at all times. The Lake area is patrolled regularly by the Park Rangers.

6. Diving restrictions include:

- Only one diver is permitted on the board.
- NO excessive bouncing.
- Before diving, be certain that the person ahead of you has surfaced and moved out of the way.
- All patrons that wish to use the 3 meter diving board (the high dive) must meet the height requirement of 58". Lifeguard approval of height is necessary before accessing the board.

**All persons must leave the park area before closing!**

7. All park users must obey recreation personnel.
8. Membership badges are not transferable.
9. Badges must be scanned when entering park at gate.
10. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the park unless:
  - A. They are accompanied by an individual who is at least 16 years old and remains with the child as long as he/she is in the park.
  - B. Any child between the ages of 12 & 14 is eligible to take a swimming test. Upon successful completion and parental approval, the child may enter the park without supervision. Tests can be arranged by contacting the Park Manager or a Certified Lifeguard.
11. Persons age 14 & up do not require a chaperone.
12. Swimming is restricted to supervised areas only.
13. Swimming & wading may be restricted to certain areas due to special activities or low attendance.
14. Members may bring up to five guests.
15. Guests must pay the daily rate
16. Non- member residents may pay the daily rate with proof of residency.
