In Pequannock:

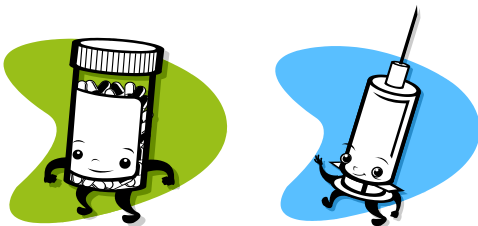
► Vegetative Waste will resume pick up every Monday, starting April 1st.

Weigh-out's will be May 14th. Stay Tuned as we Announce the Winner with the Greatest Weight Loss... Good Luck!

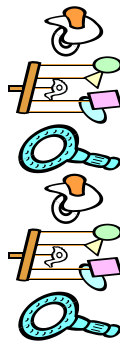
