**Fourteen years old and up must have a badge if going without a member. Under fourteen must be accompanied by an adult.**

**ALL members MUST come to the Parks & Recreation office to get a yearly validation sticker for their badge.**

Members (residents and non-residents) may bring up to five guests. No guest fee or badge is required.

# 2019 Rules & Regulations

*Woodland Lake Rules & Regulations are designed to help insure the safety and enjoyment of all park visitors. Failure to comply with the policies set may result in suspension or forfeiture of lake privileges. The following are based on Township Ordinances; prosecution may result from abuses to these rules.*

1. All boats must be registered with the Parks & Recreation office. There is a \$10 fee per boat. Annual registrations are valid January 1 - December 31.
  2. All boat decals must be displayed on the right front of the boat.
  3. No person under the age of 14 shall be permitted to boat at Woodland Lake without the supervision of an adult 18 years of age or older.
  4. All persons fishing over 16 years of age must display a NJ State fishing license. A trout stamp is also necessary when taking trout.
  5. Your Woodland Lake membership badge must be with you at all times.
  6. No limit on the number of pan fish. Limit on trout: brown, brook and rainbow is 3 per day. Limit on large mouth bass is 1 per day and must be over 18". \*Large mouth bass closed (catch & release) during NJ State spawning dates.
  7. No batfish are to be taken from the lake at any time.
  8. Bait: No killy or brackish water bait is to be used.
  9. No fish are to be cleaned in the park and all fish taken from the lake must be removed from the park.
  10. Unlawful to use net of any kind and no spears or projectiles of any make will be allowed.
  11. Rowboats, kayaks, canoes, sailboats and inflatable boats will be the only type of craft permitted. Electronic motors powered by a 12-volt battery are permitted.
- \*ALL PERSONS OPERATING A POWERED VESSEL MUST POSSESS A VALID NEW JERSEY BOAT OPERATORS LICENSE. POWER BOAT OWNERS MUST ALSO REGISTER WITH THE STATE.**
12. Inflatable boats must contain two or more chambers and must be inspected by the Parks Ranger before use on the lake.
  13. Boat size must be between 8'-16'. Canoe size must be between 10'-16'. Sailboat size must be between 8'-14'.
  14. **Stand-Up paddleboards are prohibited.**
  15. Only those facilities, which are provided by the lake for launching, are to be used.
  16. The proper number of Coast Guard approved flotation devices must be in each craft at all times, one for each passenger in the boat. Each passenger must wear a life jacket. The number of passengers must not exceed the designed capacity of the boat.
  17. **Swimming or wading is prohibited.**
  18. **Night fishing is prohibited.**
  19. **Ice fishing is prohibited** unless designated by the Director of Parks & Recreation.

- 20. Polluting and littering violate Township ordinances. Township parks are **Carry In-Carry Out**; please take all trash with you when leaving the park.
- 21. **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.**
- 22. Dogs are permitted in the park only on a leash.
- 23. Dogs are NOT permitted in the water.
