There were 3 members of the public in attendance.


Township Manager David Hollberg distributed documents related to the proposed 2018 budget and reviewed recommendations for the current fund.


Members of the Council discussed the revenues, appropriations and tax rates and agreed to review utility budgets at the Thursday February 22nd workshop.
