

The February 22, 2020 budget workshop meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, Morris County, New Jersey was called to order at 9:00 a.m. in the Municipal Building Conference Room located at 530 Newark-Pompton Turnpike; Mayor Ryan Herd presiding.

Township Manager Adam Brewer reviewed changes in line items and minor changes in procedure from the prior year.

Members of the Council and Mr. Brewer discussed options for solid waste disposal, and reviewed exhibits in the 2020 budget documents including expenses, salary and wages, components of municipal budget appropriations comparative analysis (2019 vs 2020), revenues, grants, reserve for uncollected taxes and tax increase and the Water, Sewer, Solid Waste and Recreation Utility budgets.

Capital projects including, the vehicle replacement schedule, PV Park maintenance and improvements were discussed as well as the Open Space tax rate were reviewed.


Members of the Council requested a more detailed breakdown of recreation line items.
