

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-25**

**ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$36,213.74 NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring)as follows:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$36,213.74 originally appropriated pursuant to the capital ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township") referenced in the chart below by amount, ordinance number, improvement description and date of adoption, are no longer necessary for the various purposes for which such appropriations previously were authorized:



**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
