Fax machines
Scanners
Typewriters

Materials containing liquids
Radioactive Materials
PCB containing materials
CDs, DVDs, VHS Tapes, Cassette Tapes, Wooden Speakers, Vacuum Cleaners
Light Bulbs (LED, CFL, Incandescent, etc.)
